**Number of fellowships offered:** CITEL offers thirty (30) full fellowships of the cost of economy-class airfare from the residence to the place of study. The ITU and the node involved in the program will cover the expenses for registration, airport-hotel-airport transfers, support materials, audiovisual materials, snacks, and lunch.

**Deadline for Receipt of Applications:** **August 27, 2004 in Washington, D.C., United States.** The deadline for presentation of applications to the National Liaison Office (ONE) differs from country to country and should therefore be confirmed with the relevant ONE in the applicant's country of origin.

**Course Dates:** September 27 to October 1, 2004.

**Place of study:** San José, Costa Rica

**Duration:** Five (5) days.

**Language:** *Spanish*
